Transcript

The last chapters of the Book of Judges, things like Leviticus and the sacrifices, and lots of other things that are a bit too weird for the lectionaries to include. I'm looking forward to sharing that part of the journey with you. But at this point, I want to thank everyone who has supported the project to this point.

It has meant so much to know that your prayers, your financial backing, and your recommendations have been behind this project throughout.
